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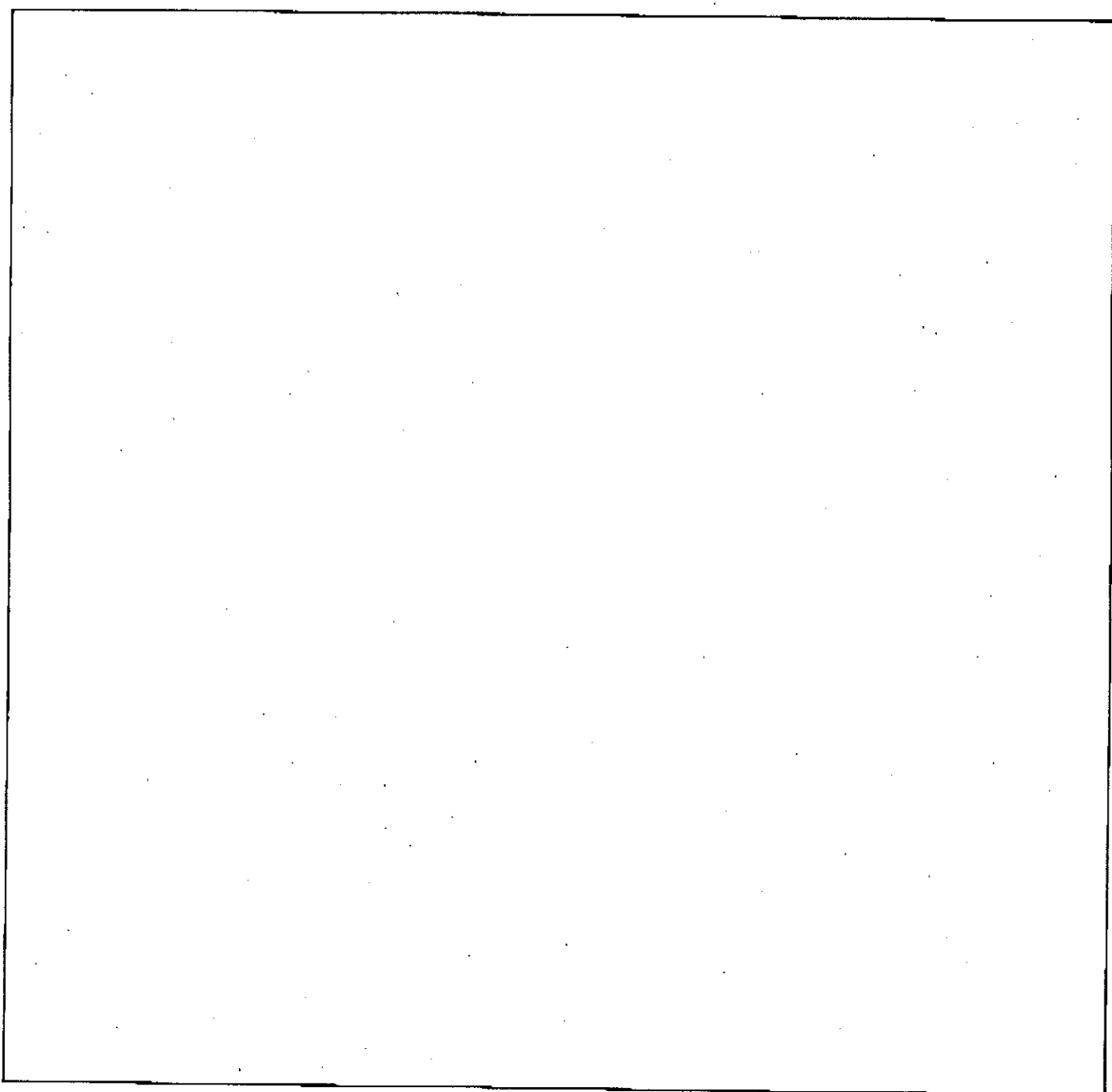

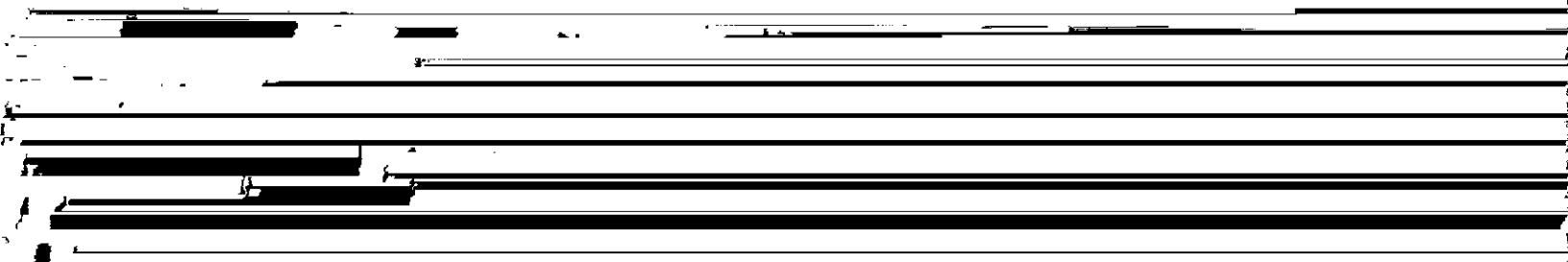

*Course Description:* A study of the geology of the terrestrial planets and solid surface moons, asteroids, comets and

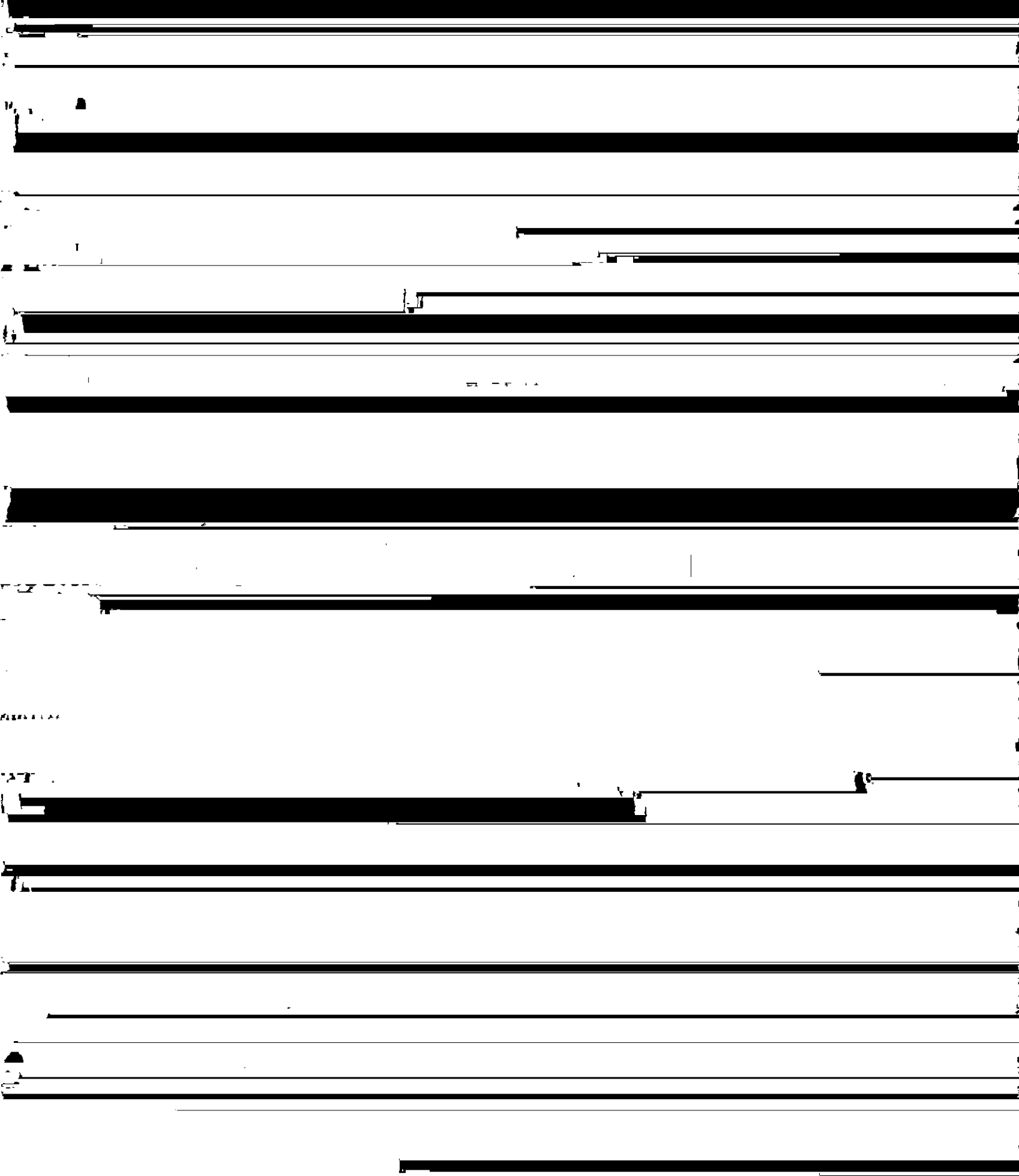
