

Total Enrollment by Gender and Ethnicity, Spring 2022




Undergraduate Enrollment, Spring 2018-2022



Undergraduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Spring 2022


Undergraduate Adult Learners by Classification and Gender, Spring 2022

Undergraduate Adult Learners by College, Spring 2022




Undergraduate Adult Learners by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2022




Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Spring 2022
