SECTION 6: DEFINITION OF HIGHLY QUALIFIED

b. The following definitions apply to the term "highly qualified" as used in this section:

(1) For purposes of this section, the term "highly qualified" means an individual who meets the following requirements:

(A) The individual is a citizen or permanent resident alien of the United States.

(B) The individual has completed a rigorous course of study that includes a minimum of 12 semester hours of college-level coursework in the field of study, including a minimum of 6 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(C) The individual has earned a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning in the field of study.

(D) The individual has completed a minimum of 24 semester hours of college-level coursework in the field of study, including a minimum of 12 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(E) The individual has earned a master's degree from an accredited institution of higher learning in the field of study.

(F) The individual has completed a minimum of 36 semester hours of college-level coursework in the field of study, including a minimum of 18 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(G) The individual has earned a doctorate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning in the field of study.

(2) For purposes of this section, the term "rigorous course of study" means a course of study that is designed to prepare an individual for a career in the field of study and that includes a minimum of 12 semester hours of college-level coursework in the field of study, including a minimum of 6 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(3) For purposes of this section, the term "advanced coursework" means coursework that is designed to prepare an individual for a career in the field of study and that includes a minimum of 6 semester hours of college-level coursework in the field of study, including a minimum of 3 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(4) For purposes of this section, the term "accredited institution of higher learning" means an institution of higher learning that is accredited by a recognized accrediting agency.

(5) For purposes of this section, the term "citizen or permanent resident alien of the United States" means an individual who is a citizen or permanent resident alien of the United States as determined by the Secretary of Education.

(6) For purposes of this section, the term "baccalaureate degree" means a degree that is awarded by an accredited institution of higher learning upon the successful completion of a minimum of 120 semester hours of college-level coursework.

(7) For purposes of this section, the term "master's degree" means a degree that is awarded by an accredited institution of higher learning upon the successful completion of a minimum of 30 semester hours of college-level coursework, including a minimum of 12 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(8) For purposes of this section, the term "doctorate degree" means a degree that is awarded by an accredited institution of higher learning upon the successful completion of a minimum of 72 semester hours of college-level coursework, including a minimum of 36 semester hours of advanced coursework.

(9) For purposes of this section, the term "recognized accrediting agency" means an accrediting agency that is recognized by the Secretary of Education.
